Why We Do It

- Since 2007, more than 1700 Calls to the national Human Trafficking hotline are about Indiana Victims
- 85% of assaults are not reported to police.
- Nearly half of LGBTQIA citizens are sexually assaulted
- 1 in 5 Hoosier women have been sexually assaulted

Our 5 Year Report

- In 2015, there were 3 designated Rape Crisis Centers covering 10 counties or 10% of the state. In 2020, there are 13 Rape Crisis Centers offering services to 43 counties or 46% of the state.
- In 2015, there were 16 SARTs representing 19 counties or 20% of the state. In 2020, there are 40 SARTs representing 50 counties of 54% of Indiana.
- The 150-member IPATH Taskforce includes six working committees and uses a survivor-centered approach to more effectively prevent, detect, and prosecute human trafficking in Indiana and to empower and support survivors.
- Since 2015, we have either hosted or presented at:
 - 4 statewide conferences • 9 CORE 40 trainings for sexual assault advocates
 - 19 regional meetings across the state • 159 trainings, webinars and livestreams
